We do such local activity in District, Residents Association

◎ Disaster prevention activities and Crime prevention activities

- In preparation for a disaster, we conduct disaster prevention drills, maintain and manage stockpile items.
- Aiming for a crime-free town, we do security light equipment management and security patrols.

If you are not a member of the District, Residents Association

Just in case something happened "unexpectedly", it is difficult to help each other unless you know your neighbors. The connection between local people is important.



◎ Environmental beautification activities

- We work on "garbage station", maintenance and cleaning of roads and parks in the district.

If you are not a member of the District, Residents Association

In the "garbage station", it can't be used by non-residents in principle, so no garbage can be taken out.



◎ Friendship and support activities

- We hold Children's Associations and festivals to deepen the connections and exchange between residents.
- From children to elder, everyone in the area watches over and supports each other.

Notice of the district events such as "Children's Association, Festival" will not be delivered.

District, Residents Association Q and A

Q1. What is District, Residents Association?

A1. District, Residents Association are voluntary organizations organized and run by residents. Suwa-shi has 90 Districts, Residents Associations. For peaceful living and development of town, we're inviting you to join.

Q2. What is District fee? How are District fees used?

A2. District fee is money collected for administration of District, Residents Association. The amount of the District fee and how it is used is determined by the local residents. In general, it is used for various local activities such as maintenance and management costs such as electricity for crime prevention lights, purchase of emergency stocks, maintenance and management of meeting place (public halls), and exchange events between residents. It is also used for a variety of local activities.

Q3. Isn't the City hall doing the local things because we're paying taxes?

A3. In Suwa-shi, the District, Residents Association and the government share roles with each other and work together to promote community development. District, Residents Association and local governments, who know the area well, are working together to solve local issues as shown on the left.
