Garbage must be put out at the designated collection point on the appointed day/time

Burnable garbage collection

- There is no garbage collection on August 15th and from December 30th to January 3rd.
- Collection will also be conducted on public holidays and substitute holidays.
- Garbage must be put out between 6:00 and 8:30 a.m. on the day of collection.

- Garbage collection also has a holiday and a public holiday.
- Garbage must be put out at the designated garbage collection point on the day of collection by 8:30 a.m.
- Please put it out on the collection day for your area.
- Batteries are only collected on the second collection day of the month.

Burnable garbage

- Collection will also be conducted on public holidays and substitute holidays.
- There is no garbage collection on August 15, or between December 30 and January 3.
- Garbage must be put out at the designated garbage collection point on the day of collection by 8:30 a.m.
- Garbage must be disposed of in Suwa City-issued burnable garbage bags.
- Make sure to write the name of your neighborhood on each garbage bag.
- **Starting in April 2025, the method for separating plastics will change, and "soft plastics" that have been disposed of as "burnable garbage" will now be disposed of as "other plastics."**

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Kitchen Waste</u></p> <p>*Food waste, bones, shells, etc. *Drain off the excess water from food waste. ◆ Food waste can also be disposed of in disposal units available for subsidized purchase.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">  </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Dirty plastics</u></p> <p>* Soiled food containers. However, once cleaned, it goes into the "other plastics" category. *Disposable lighters must be emptied of lighter fluid before being thrown out as garbage.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">  </div>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Futon</u></p> <p>◆ Futon and other large burnable items too big to fit in the appointed bag must be taken to Shinshu Takei Co. Ltd. *Tie zabuton together in bundles of twos or threes</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Tree trimmings and branches</u></p> <p>*Tree trimmings and branches must be less than 60cm in length and tied in bundles (with any roots removed). *Plant roots are to be placed in Suwa City-issued burnable garbage bags.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Wood Planks</u></p> <p>*Wood planks must be less than 60cm in length and tied together in bundles. *All nails must be removed.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Grass Cuttings</u></p> <p>* Please dispose of grass clippings, weeds, and dead leaves in commercially available transparent or semi-transparent bags of 45L or less. Grass cuttings, weeds, and dead leaves must be disposed of in the appointed bag. No other garbage should be disposed of in these bags.</p>	

Collection of Recyclables

- Recyclable materials must be placed in the appointed container, basket, or bag.
- Do not put out old paper and clothes out on rainy or snowy days.
- Items that are too large to fit into a mesh basket or container cannot be collected and must be taken directly to a designated waste disposal facility. (see page 5)

Paper

- *Newspapers, magazines, books, and cardboard must be separated and tied in individual bundles
- *Advertising leaflets should be bundled together with newspapers.
- *Newspapers older than 3 months must be put out together with magazines.

Other paper: wrapping paper, envelopes, cigarette boxes, etc.

*Other paper is to be placed in paper bags tied tightly together with string.



*Tissues, tin foil, plastic-coated paper, and other special types of paper must be put out as burnable garbage.

Cartons: Paper cartons (milk, juice, alcoholic beverage cartons, etc.)

*Cut open and flatten.

*Wash and dry.

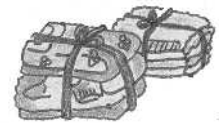
*Remove caps.



old clothes

* Please place T-shirts, jumpers, trousers, towels, etc., without tying them up, in the collection bags provided at the garbage stations.

* You can't put it out on rainy or snowy days. Dirty or torn items should go in the category.



Cans

Aluminum and steel cans

*Drink cans, tin cans, etc.

*Rinse all cans clean.



Spray cans

*A hole must be pierced in cans before they can be discarded. Make sure to check they are empty before piercing them (do not do this near open flames).



Plastic

Plastic items that are old or cannot be rinsed clean must be put out as burnable garbage.

PET bottles

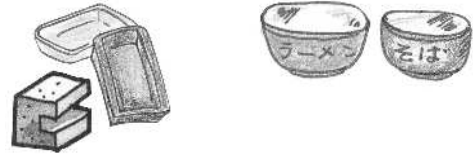


- *These bottles display a 'PET' recycling symbol.
- *PET bottle caps should be removed and disposed of with 'other plastics'.
- *Make sure to rinse PET bottles out.
- * Please remove the label and dispose of it as "burnable waste".



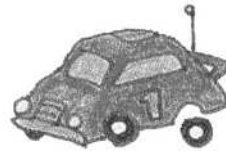
Styrofoam trays & other items

- *Wash and dry all styrofoam containers.
- *Remove food waste, etc. from trays.



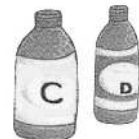
Other Plastics

- *CD /DVD cases
- *Wash bowls, buckets, etc.
- *Convenience store bento packaging, strawberry containers, plastic egg cartons, etc.
- *Toys, etc.
- *Screws and all other metal parts must be removed.
- * **Plastic bags and candy wrappers that you previously treated as "burnable garbage" should now be disposed of as "other plastics."**



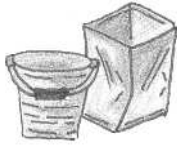
Glass Bottles

- *Colorless glass bottles
- *Brown glass bottles
- *Glass bottles of other colors
- *Caps must be removed
- *Bottles must be rinsed out



Metals

*Pans, kettles, metal boxes, buckets, frying pans, etc.



*Bladed items: razors, kitchen knives, etc.
*Items must be wrapped in newspaper.



*Electronic goods: hair dryers, electric cables, rice cookers, Thermos flasks, etc.

*Mechanical items: cameras, watches, etc.

*Metal objects exceeding the size of the appointed recycling container cannot be put out for collection.

*There is no need to disassemble the above items.



Glass & ceramics

*Ceramics: rice bowls, flower pots, dishes, etc.

*Glass items: sheet glass, glass drinking vessels, dishes, mirrors etc.

*Cosmetics bottles, oil stained bottles etc.

*Cosmetic bottles must be emptied before being thrown out. Caps that are burnable or recyclable must also be removed. Separate empty bottles by color and throw them out with other glass bottles.

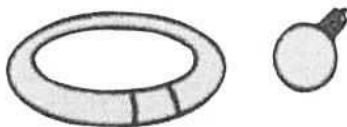
*Broken glass items and mirrors must be wrapped in cloth. Make sure to attach a tag indicating that broken glass is contained.



Batteries Fluorescent Light Bulbs / Light Bulbs/ Glow Starters

*These are only collected on the first collection day of the month.

*Fluorescent light bulbs and regular light bulbs must be put out in their original packaging or wrapped in newspaper.



Batteries

*Batteries are only collected on the second collection day of the month.

*Items must be placed in the appointed yellow container.

*Lithium batteries, nickel-cadmium batteries and button batteries must be returned to the store where purchased.
